

MINGUS MOUNTAIN CAMPOUT

Friday - Sunday, August 4th - 6th

The Playground Group Site is located in the pines at 7,500 feet atop Mingus Mountain in the Prescott National Forest. The site is shaded by sycamore & located near many trails. The site has tables, grills, trash dumpster, vault toilet, is fenced in but does not have water.

Plan to arrive anytime after 1 pm on **Friday, August 4th**. The gate will be locked before that time. Drive in and pick a place to camp. Our campsite is near Jerome, Sedona & Prescott Valley. Check out time on Sunday is **11 am**.

Coffee will be brewed each morning starting at 6 am. Please bring your favorite mug.

Get up close & personal with the hang gliders as they jump off the side of the mountain. A short hike will take you to the jump off point with panoramic views of the Verde Valley. You can sit 10 feet away from the hang gliders as they jump and soar out over the valley.

Camping fees are: Members \$30 / Non-Members \$35

Remember to bring food, drinking water & firewood. Your well-behaved dogs are welcome.

Some things to do: Mingus lake is a short walk away and a little farther is a lookout from the side of the mountain where you can see the Verde Valley.

Things to know in advance: Quiet time is from **10 pm - 6 am**. One power outlet is available for phone charging.

Directions: Take the **I-17** Freeway **north** to Cordes Junction, approximately 47 miles north from the junction of **101** and **I-17**. At Cordes Junction take exit **262**, which is **SR-69**. Continue driving Northwest on **SR-69** passing by/through Mayer, Poland Junction, Meadow, and Humboldt. Just before Dewey you will see **SR-169**, **But Stay On SR-69** and 2.4 miles past **SR-169**, turn right onto Prescott Country Club Blvd / Fain Rd. This becomes Fain Rd., which you will follow north until you reach **SR-89A**, (see map on back). Drive about 13 miles and turn right onto **FR-104**, (there is a 7023 elevation sign on your left). Drive for approximately 1.5 miles to the entrance to the Playground Group Site, on the left. For online directions go to <http://maps.google.com/>.
